The Third Global Chinese Ophthalmic Conference in conjunction with the XI National Congress of Chinese Ophthalmological Society will be held at the Beijing



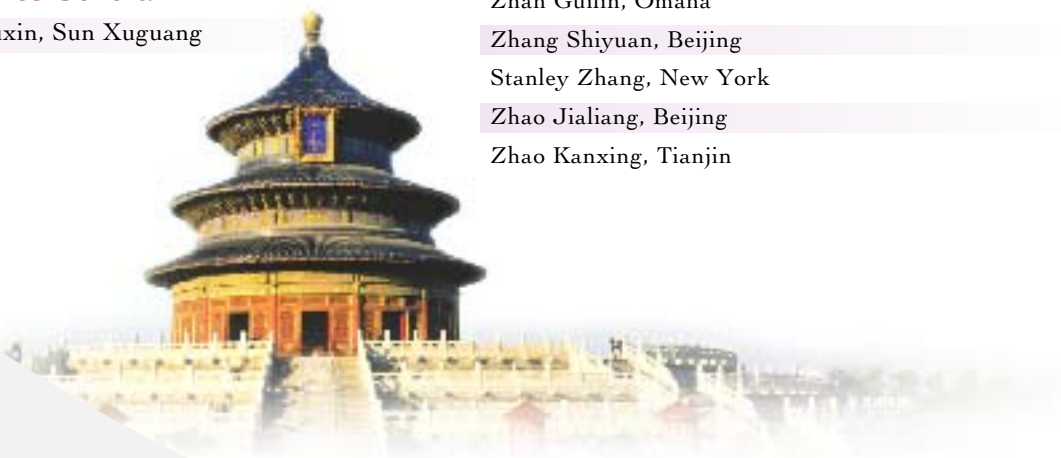

Call for Abstracts, Video Materials, and Ophthalmic Pictures and Paintings

The Scientific Committee invites all interested individuals to submit abstracts, video materials, ophthalmic pictures and paintings on ophthalmology or vision-related basic science, clinical research, management, research methodology and the ophthalmic education for consideration of presentation at the Congress. Accepted abstracts will be presented as oral, poster or published only and published in the Congress Abstracts Book. Deadline for submission of abstracts, video materials, and ophthalmic pictures and paintings is **June 30, 2006**.

- * The congress reserves the copy rights to the printed abstracts in the abstracts book.
- * All abstracts will not be returned to the authors.

Presentation Formats

1. Oral Presentation (Free Paper Session)

Slides should be prepared in both English and Chinese

Time allocation: 8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion

2. Poster Presentation

100cm (width) by 245cm(height) display boards will be provided for poster presentations. Contents should cover brief written sections for the introduction, methods, results and conclusions of the presented study.

Poster Size: 1.5m (height) X 0.9m (width)

3. Video Presentation

Room for circulating video presentation is provided. Please prepare video tape, VCD or DVD disc, which is not over 30 minutes.

4. Photographs

High-quality photos of both anterior and posterior segment of the eye, fundus fluorescein angiogram and ophthalmic painting.

Size: 210mmX297mm

5. Publish Only

Abstract accepted as Published Only will not be presented at the Congress, but will appear in the Abstract Book.

Abstract Preparation Guidelines

1. Abstracts can be submitted in either English or Chinese

2. Limit your abstracts to 600 words.

3. Arrange your abstract as follows:

- a) A Title: brief and clear, do not indent
- b) Authors: all authors names without degrees or titles
- c) Institution, city and country, detailed mailing address or E-mail address, and zip code should be included.
- d) Purpose: Indicate the goal of the project.
- e) Methods: Describe the study design and analysis methods.
- f) Results: Report the data resulting from the study.
- g) Conclusions: Interpret the results and indicate their significance
- h) Do not include references in the abstract.

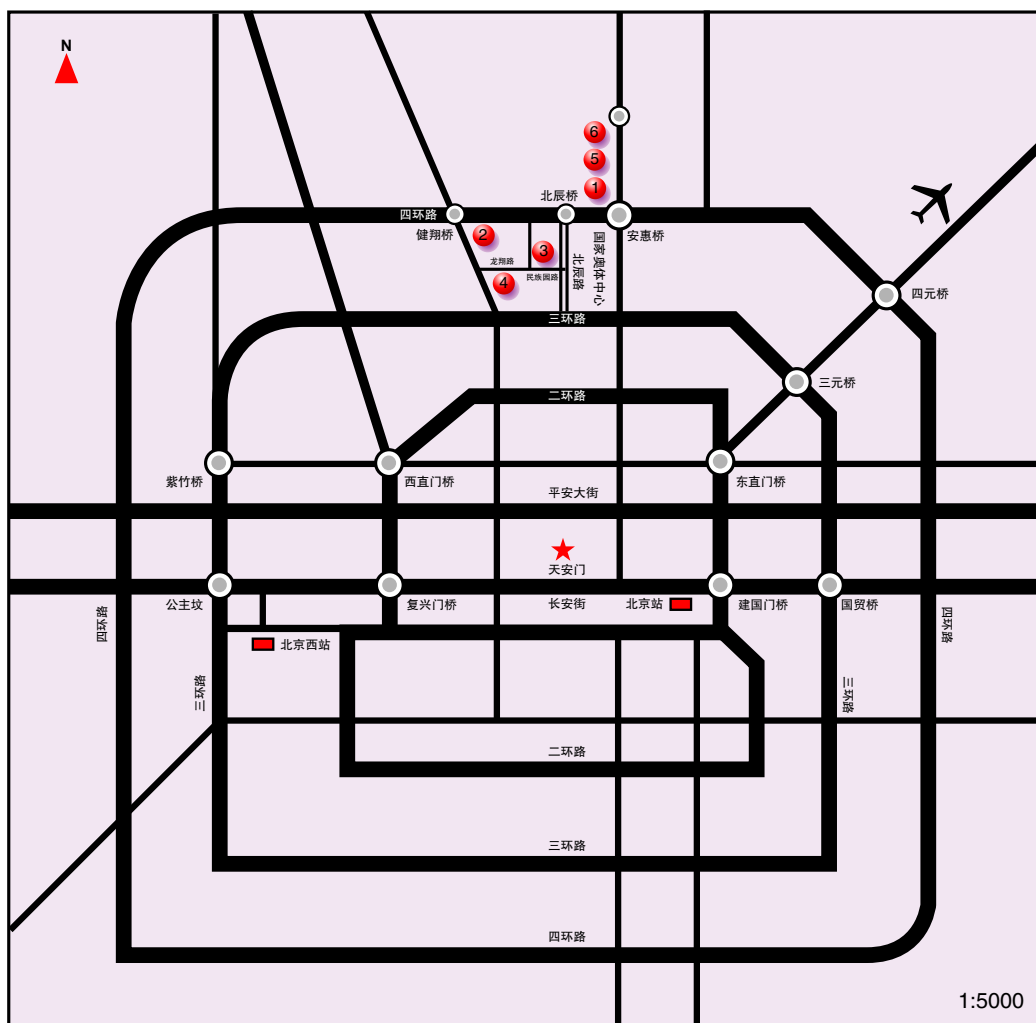
