



# CUHK-HKEH Joint International Ophthalmology Fellowship Program

## Aims

1. To provide subspecialty training and enhancement (clinical and / or laboratory) of high international standard to up and coming ophthalmologists, from overseas or mainland China;
2. To foster professional ties and collaboration between The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) / Hong Kong Eye Hospital (HKEH), and ophthalmology departments and institutes, overseas or in mainland China, sharing the same vision of advancement through pursuance of excellence.

## Eligibility

1. Applicants should be under the age of 45, and have completed a residency in general ophthalmology;
2. Preference will be given to individuals who have completed a full subspecialty fellowship program, and have a strong track record in research and publication;
3. Applicants must be able to communicate in written and spoken English.
